Clarence Sharp *H-R* Dies Thursday

Clarence W. Sharp, 64, of Rte. 3, Grinnell, died early Thursday morning at Community hospital.

The son of Frank E. and Mary Doak Sharp, Mr. Sharp was born on Feb. 5, 1903, in Kellogg. He attended the rural schools and on Jan. 5, 1928 married Esther Richardson at Newton.

Following their marriage the couple farmed in the Kellogg and Killduff communities. For the past 25 years they have farmed north of Grinnell in the Newburg community.

Mr. Sharp was a member of the United Church of Christ (Congregational), Newburg, and was a member of the Men's Club of the church.

Survivors include his widow; one son, Delmar, of Kellogg; three grandchildren, Scott, Curtis, and Tracey Lynn Sharp; four brothers, Donald of Killduff, Vernon of Newton, Otto of Kellogg, and Oakley of Kellogg.

He was preceded in death by his parents; one brother, Maxwell, who died at the age of 13; and one sister, Florence, who died in infancy.

Funeral services for Mr. Sharp will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday at the James Schalinske Funeral Home with the Rev. Richard Hempenius and the Rev. Helen Turner officiating.

Burial will be in Our Silent City cemetery at Kellogg.
