1912 May Clayworth Shaw,
daughter of Josie and Joseph
Clayworth was born near Kel-
logg, Ia., on August 19, 1875.
While she was still a girl the
family moved to Grinnell.

She was united in marriage
to Herbert Oren Shaw on No-
vember 27, 1894 in the Salva-
tion Army building at Grinnell.
In their youth both Mr. and
Mrs. Shaw were officers in the
Salvation Army.

The couple united with the
Methodist church in Grinnell,
where they were faithful mem-
bers until moving to Rock Rap-
ids in 1945, when they united
with the church here.

Survivors are her husband;
three children, Wendell Harris
Shaw of Green Bay, Wis., Mrs.
Francis Chase (Nellie) of Ames;
and Mrs. Glen Richards (Hes-
ter) of Rock Rapids; a brother,
J. E. Clayworth of Kansas City,
