Ralph Jay Shaw, 65, retired Victor rural mail carrier, succumbed Tuesday evening at a Knoxville hospital where he had been a patient for some time.

Services were held Friday afternoon at Victor with the Rev. N. F. Grote officiating. Music was furnished by Art Lang and Ruth Ocheltree. Interment was in the IOOF cemetery at Brooklyn.

Born at Carnforth on Sept. 29th, 1894, he was the son of John and Kate Price Shaw and was married to Adaline Oneyear at Manchester on Sept. 27th, 1922.
