

Tim Sheehy Dies; Former Postmaster At Searsboro

Timothy Patrick Sheehy, former postmaster at Searsboro, died Sunday morning at a local hospital following a one-year illness. He was 75 years old.

Faithful Church-Goer

Sheehy was born Dec. 5, 1882, on a farm five miles south of Sully, the son of Jeremiah and Ellen Sullivan Sheehy. When 12 years old, he moved with the family to Searsboro, where he attended the Catholic church until it was disbanded. Later, he attended mass in Grinnell.

Postmaster for 13 years, Sheehy also operated a drug store and produce business.

Wife Survives

He is survived by his wife, the former Charlotte Agnes Danforth, and two brothers, Thomas of Nashua, Minn., and Jerry of Searsboro.

Rosary service will be conducted this evening at 8 p.m. at Smith Funeral Home by Rev. V. A. Walsh. Requiem high mass will be held in St. Mary's Catholic church at 9 a.m. Tuesday morning, with burial in Calvary cemetery, Searsboro.
