Taintor man is electrocuted

A Taintor man was electrocuted Monday when the auger he was using to unload seed at a Steamboat Rock elevator came in contact with high-voltage wires, Hardin County authorities said.

Jack Sheesley of New Sharon and Norman Sheesley of San Diego, Calif.; and two sisters, Mrs. Kenneth Bushong of Montezuma and Mrs. Dale May of Grinnell.

Norris Fox Sheesley, 49, was pronounced dead on arrival at an Eldora hospital. He had been working as a driver for Golden Sun Feeds of Grinnell at the time of his death.

The fatal accident occurred at 10:30 a.m.

Funeral services for Mr. Sheesley will be held at 2 p.m. today at the Harden Funeral Home in New Sharon, with the Rev. Scott Woodworth officiating. Burial will be at Highland Cemetery, New Sharon.

Mr. Sheesley was a lifelong resident of the Taintor and New Sharon areas.
