Frances Jane Sheline was born in West Virginia, August, 31, 1844, and departed this life, July 30, 1921, aged 76 years, and 11 months. She was married to Samuel Sheline, January 27, 1859. To this union were born thirteen children, seven of whom preceded her to the better land. Her husband also preceded her on March 18, 1921, being four months and twelve days. She leaves to mourn her loss, six children: D. M. Sheline of St. Joseph, Mo.; Mrs. M. W. Boram of Kellerton, Iowa; Mr. R. F. Sheline of University Park, Iowa; Mr. S. U. She has been a great suffer for years with organic heart trouble but at the last she was seriously ill only forty-eight hours.
