Sybil S. Sherman, 87, of Grinnell died of congestive heart failure Friday, May 10, at Friendship Manor.

The daughter of Lewis and Elca May Abalon Sheets, she was born July 29, 1908, at Ollie, Iowa. She was raised in Ollie and attended school there. In 1929, she received her B.A. degree in education from the former Iowa State Teachers College in Cedar Falls. She then taught at Ollie.

She was married to William M. Sherman in 1936 in Cedar Rapids. They lived in Cedar Rapids, and she later taught at Hampton, Geneva, Chapin and Newburg. From 1959 to 1973, she taught math and typing at the former Grinnell Junior High School. She retired in 1973.

Mrs. Sherman was a member of the United Church of Christ - Congregational, the Iowa Education Association and Delta Kappa Gamma.

She is survived by three sons.
