

Robert Shope Services Held

Robert ¹⁴⁻² ~~E.~~ Shope, 66, of Gladbrook died Wednesday, Aug. 15, at his home. He had been in failing health.

Born Sept. 30, 1906, at Sheridan, he was the son of Jacob and Elma Bubb Shope. He received his education in the Grinnell schools.

On Jan. 25, 1927, he was married to Etta Snow at Toledo, and they spent their married life in Central Iowa, moving to Gladbrook in 1940. Mr. Shope was employed for 42 years by the Iowa Electric Light and Power Co.

He was a member of the Olivet Masonic Lodge No. 436.
