## Brooklyn Rites Conducted For Margaret Simpson

Funeral services for Mrs. Margaret M. Simpson, 87, a Malcom resident for many years, were held July 2nd at 2 p.m. at the First United Presbyterian church in Brooklyn with the Rev. George W. Roquet officiating. Mrs. Ed Bartachek was organist.

Mrs. Simpson's death occurred June 29th, 1965, at the home of her daughter in Malcom.
