

Marengo Rites for Howard Slaymaker

Funeral services were conducted Dec. 9 for Howard Slaymaker, 58, of Marengo who died of a heart attack Dec. 7 while operating a snow plow near the Victor interchange on Interstate 80.

Rev. Stanley Kennedy officiated at the service and burial was in the Koszta cemetery where the American Legion conducted graveside services.

Slaymaker, a lifelong resident of Marengo, is survived by three brothers, McClellan, William and Gerald, all of Marengo.
