## Tuesday Services Planned Here For B. Sleeuwenhoek

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday from the Northside Friends church for Barend Sleeuwenhoek, 77, of Grinnell, who died Saturday at a local hospital following several months of illness.

Officiating at the services will be the Rev. Myron Harris. Vocal music will be provided by Dorothy Wiley, accompanied on the organ by Lois Van Donselaar.

Pallbearers will be Eugene Ray, Norman Schutte, Wayne Van Dalen, C. R. Van Dalen, John White, and Kenneth Clausen. Interment will be in Mount Zion cemetery south of Newton with James-Schalinske Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

Born in Rotterdam, Holland, on August 24, 1886, he came to this country as a young man and settled on a farm in the Killduff vicinity. In 1938 he moved to a farm near Grinnell and continued to farm in the Grinnell and Kellogg communities until his retirement in 1952.

On September 6, 1917, he was united in marriage with Mabel Clausen, and to this union were born one daughter and seven sons.

He is survived by his daughter Grace of Grinnell; six sons, Alfred of Newton, Lawrence of Malcom, Earl, Wendell and Norman of Grinnell, and Lloyd of Victor. Also surviving are nine grandchildren and one nephew, D. W. Sleeuwenhoek of Atlanta, Ga.

He was preceded in death by his wife in 1935 and a son, Carroll Wesley, in infancy.
