Beatrice McDowell Small, 69, of Springfield, Va., formerly of Grinnell, the widow of Emmett R. Small, died Tuesday morning, Mar. 19, in Fairfax County, Va.

The daughter of William and Mattie Miller Johnson, she was born July 28, 1904, in Searshoro. She attended local schools and was graduated from Grinnell High School.

She was married to Emmett R. Small on Nov. 12, 1933, in St. Louis, Mo. The couple had one daughter, Mrs. Elaine Small Warren of Springfield, Va.
