Funeral services will be held Saturday, at 2 p.m. at the Smith funeral home for Thomas Smiley, 76, who died Wednesday at his home near Grinnell after an illness of about two years.

He is survived by his wife, Marjory, and five brothers and sisters, Wilfred S. Smiley, Grinnell; M. H. Smiley, Dallas Center, Iowa; Dr. W. A. Smiley, Chicago; Mrs. R. J. (Lucile) Fallin, St. Petersburg, Fla., and Miss Leona Smiley, Charles City.
