

Schoonhoven services held

Gerrit J. Schoonhoven, 85, of Holland, Minn., died Thursday, April 30, at the home of his daughter, Lucille Jansen of Sully.

Funeral services were conducted on Monday at the Christian Reformed Church in Holland, with burial in the Holland Cemetery. Memorials may be left at the Smith Funeral Home in Grinnell.

The son of Henry and Lucille Van Dyke Schoonhoven, he was born March 29, 1902, in Oldebrook, The Netherlands. He was educated there, moving to the U.S. in 1919. He was married to Gertrude Van Hill in Steen, Minn., and the couple farmed in that area before
