Fred Schrader, 62, of 521 Main St., died suddenly of an apparent heart attack Saturday morning.

The son of John and Anna Hofmaster Schrader, he was born near Marengo June 15, 1910. He was married to Jean McBlain March 15, 1933, in Chicago, Ill. The couple had two daughters, both of whom survive: Mrs. Arthold (Anne) Williams of Corona, Calif., and Mrs. David (Susan) Sears of Pleasantville.
