Rites Held for
Andrew Schultz

Andrew W. Schultz, 89, a former resident of Grinnell, died Nov. 15 at Encino Gardens Nursing Home in Albuquerque, N. M., it has been learned.

The son of Mr. and Mrs. Christian Schultz, he was born Nov. 28, 1883, near Grinnell. He attended the German Lutheran Bible School near Grinnell and was confirmed and joined the Lutheran Church at the age of 17. He later joined the Methodist Church.

Mr. Schultz was married to Mabel Pearl Wilson at the home of her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Robert Wilson, near Letts, Iowa. She was teaching school at Grinnell at that time.

The couple had lived in Albuquerque the past 13 years.

Survivors include his wife; a son, Lt. Col. Andrew M. Schultz, stationed with the U.S. Air Force at Abilene, Tex.; two daughters, Mrs. William (Bernice) Runge and Mrs. Arlene Wardlow, both of Albuquerque; seven grandchildren; and two great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by four brothers and two sisters at Grinnell.

Funeral services for Mr. Schultz were held Nov. 17. Burial was in Sandia Memory Gardens, Albuquerque.
