Schultz dies

in New York

August H. Schultz, 79, long a resident of Kellogg, died Sunday afternoon in Ithaca, N.Y. *May 6*

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Wednesday at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Kellogg. The Rev. Ernest Elzey, pastor of the church, officiated. Burial was in Our Silent City Cemetery in Kellogg.

Born Nov. 15, 1899, in Grinnell, he was the son of August and Doris Schultz. He married Margaret Ruth Turner on July 11, 1919, in Rock Island, Ill.
