Services held today for Mrs. Ella Broders Schultz

Mrs. Ella Broders Schultz, 76, of 117 Eighth Ave. died Thursday evening, May 19, at her home.

She was the daughter of Otto C. and Katherine Schafer Broders, and was born in Sheridan Township near Malcom. She attended the schools near the family home, and also attended Grinnell High School. She was married to Lyle Herman and they farmed in the Sheridan Community until his death on June 9, 1943. During World War II, she lived in Belmont, Ia., for a time before returning to Grinnell.

She was married to Edwin "Nels" Anderson, and the couple continued to make their home in Grinnell. Mr. Anderson died in 1958. In May of 1959, she was married to Raymond Schultz. Mr. Schultz preceded her in death in September of 1975.

Mrs. Schultz was a member of the Sheridan United Methodist Church and was a member of the Sheridan and Grinnell W.S.C.S. groups in the

churches. She was employed for a few years at the Spurgeon Department Store.

She is survived by her brother, Elmer Broders of Grinnell, as well as a number of nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her parents; three husbands; and two brothers and two sisters, Lester and Russell Broders, Mrs. Myrtle Baustian, and Mrs. Eva Hansen.

Funeral services for Ella Schultz will be held at 2 p.m. today (Monday) at the Sheridan Methodist Church, with the Rev. James P. Russell, minister of the Grinnell United Methodist Church, officiating. Organist will be Miss Donna Overturf.
