Funeral services were held Friday morning at the Elk Creek Lutheran church south of town, for Mrs. Melvin L. Schultz, who died at Skiff Memorial hospital in Newton Tuesday evening, May 21, following a Caesarian operation.

Frances Ilean Castorf, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Fred Castorf, was born Dec. 3, 1906, on a farm near Sully, Iowa. She attended the Newton schools and was graduated with the class of 1924. Following her graduation she taught for two years in the rural schools of Jasper county.

She was united in marriage to Melvin L. Schultz of Keasnor September 3, 1930, and they made their home on the Schultz farm northeast of that place.

She united with the Elk Creek Lutheran church by confirmation November 16, 1919, and was an active member of that congregation.

A baby daughter, Doris Ilean, preceded her in death.

Surviving relatives include her husband, a daughter, Dorothy Ann, 2 years of age; her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Fred Castorf; one sister, Evelyn, and her grandmother, Mrs. John A. Schnell of Newton.
