Island Marie Schultz was born May 16, 1979 at Carmichael, Calif., the daughter of Shelly Kramer.

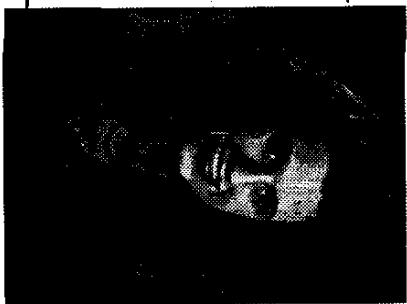
