

Wilbur Schultz Dies In Tama

Wilbur H. Schultz, 73, of Tama, a well known former Sheridan area farmer, died at Grinnell General Hospital early Monday, November 2, where he had been a patient for two weeks. He had been in failing health for two years.

Born Nov. 16, 1896, in Sheridan Township, Malcom, he was the son of Otto and Sophia Luttmann Schultz. He attended Sheridan Township School No. 5 and he graduated from Mar-

shalltown Institute of Business.

At the home of his bride's parents he married Elva Graham in Sheridan Township on Feb. 12, 1919. The couple farmed in the Sheridan community. Mrs. Schultz died Jan. 6, 1947. An aunt, Mrs. Verna Engel, made her home with Mr. Schultz and in 1962 they retired to Tama.

Mr. Schultz was a member of the Sheridan United Methodist Church, a longtime member of the Grinnell Elks Lodge, Poweshiek County Farm Bureau and he held office in his school district.

Preceding him in death, beside his wife, were his parents and two brothers, Omer and Clifton.

Surviving are two daughters, Mrs. Floyd (Janyce) Heishman and Mrs. Robert (Linda) Overturf, both of rural Malcom; seven grandchildren - Mrs. Dave Heise of Grinnell, Larry and Shirley Heishman, Donna, Dianne, Michael and Jane Overturf, all of rural Malcom. Also surviving are a sister and brother, Mrs. Wayne (Edna) Reams and Raymond Schultz, both of Grinnell; and his mother-in-law, Mrs. Nettie Graham of Toledo.
