Snyder rites

held Dec. 8

Herbert Snyder of Pella died late Monday evening, Dec. 4, at the Iowa Methodist Medical Center in Des Moines. He was a former resident of Grinnell.

Funeral services for Herbert Snyder were held at 10:30 a.m. on Friday, Dec. 8 at the First Baptist Church in Pella, with the Rev. Ronald E. Cowles officiating.

Music was provided by Kathy Lucas, vocalist, and Jean De Wild, organist. Casket bearers were Ronnie Allison, Harold Hastings, John Hastings, Tom Kading, Tony Stravers, and Lawrence Van Zante. Interment was in Forest Cemetery in Oskaloosa.

D. Herbert Snyder was born July 31, 1916, near Leon in Decatur County, where he spent his childhood. He was the son of Dwight E. and Ethel Scott Snyder.

He graduated from Leon High School in 1934, and married Louise Upton in Otumwa on Aug. 15, 1940. Following their marriage, they lived in Oskaloosa for a short while, then moved to Grinnell, where they lived for 11 years. While living here, he was a partner in the H. and S. Gas Co.

In 1960, the couple moved to Pella. He retired in 1975 as assistant resident engineer for the Army Corps of Engineers at Lake Red Rock.

Surviving him are his wife, Louise, his daughters, Mrs. Tim (Susan) Sellers of Marshalltown; Mrs. Kyle (Kristin) Steenhoek of Pella; his mother, a patient at the Pleasant Park Manor in Oskaloosa; three brothers, William Snyder of Pella, Lester of Oskaloosa, and Doyle of Boulder, Colo.

Preceding him in death were his father; one infant sister, Clyta; and one infant son, Michael.
