

Squire Services To Be Tuesday ¹⁹⁶⁶

Walter Gray Squire, 80, of New Albany, Ohio, passed away near his home Friday afternoon.

He was born August 25, 1886, near Grinnell, one of a family of three sons born to Hiram and Emily Clay Squire. He attended the local schools near Grinnell, and he operated his own nursery and fruit farm west of town. He later ran his own gasoline station at the east edge of Grinnell for several years.

On December 4, 1907, he was united in marriage with Ollie Turney at the Turney home in Chester Township. To this union were born five children, four of whom survive: Mrs. Mable Sherod of Indianola, Mrs. Glenn (Hazel) Dexter of Grinnell, Harold W. Squire of Columbus, Ohio, and Donald E. Squire, also of Columbus. Another son, Kenneth, died in infancy.

His wife, Ollie Squire, passed away on July 25, 1951, and Mr. Squire later married Dorothy Brown on August 25, 1956. She survives him at the home in New Albany, Ohio.

In addition to his widow and four children, Mr. Squire is survived by 14 grandchildren, 19 great grandchildren, and several other relatives. He was preceded in death by his parents, his first wife Ollie, his son Kenneth, one grandchild, and his two brothers, Arthur and William.

He had moved from Grinnell to Ohio about 20 years ago where he was associated with his son in the Squire Furnace and Heating Co. at Columbus. He was a member of the Church of Christ near his home.

Funeral services for Walter Gray Squire will be held at 2 p.m. Tuesday at the Smith Funeral Home with the Rev. Mr. Roy A. Coop, pastor of the Grinnell Christian church, officiating.
