Mrs. Stanley is survived by her son Kenneth R. Stanley of Deerfield, Ill.; her daughter-in-law Elaine Stanley of Montezuma; six grandchildren and two great-grandchildren. Besides her parents and husband, she was preceded in death by a son Craig Stanley in May of 1971, a daughter Kathleen who died in infancy, and three sisters.
