Services Wednesday For Mrs. Stanley

Funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon, Jan. 26, for Mrs. Lulu Maiden Stanley at the Estel-Perrin Funeral home in Marshalltown. Mrs. Stanley was the mother of Mrs. Hoyt Bonham of Montezuma.

Mrs. Stanley, 85, who made her home with her daughter, Mrs. Olga DeViley, Marshalltown, died Sunday evening. She had been in failing health for the last three months.
