Paul F. Stanley, son of John Timothy and Etta Violet Myers Stanley, was born March 19, 1905, at the home in Grant Township, Poweshiek County, Iowa. He attended the Grinnell schools, and farmed most of his life.

He was married March 20, 1926 to Grace Hoffstader, at Newton, Iowa. Two daughters were born to the home, Lois Mae, and Betty Maxine.

During his lifetime he was a member of Fraternal orders and of the Veterans of Foreign Wars. He engaged in farming until ill health came in 1943, and in 1945 he began traveling with construction work. For the past three years he has been with construction in Iowa City where he moved about 1954.

On May 10, Paul Stanley was stricken with serious illness, and he passed away following surgery on May 18, 1957, at Iowa City. He was past 52 years of age. He was preceded in death by his parents and one daughter, Lois Mae Stanley.
