Funeral services for Roy Steenhoek, 63, Rte. 4, Grinnell will be held at 1:30 p.m. Wednesday at Smith Funeral Home with Dr. G. S. Bruland of the Methodist church officiating.

Mr. Steenhoek died suddenly Sunday afternoon at a local hospital where he had been a patient for three days.

A resident of Poweshiek county most of his life, he was the son of Cornelius and Cornelia Dunnick Steenhoek, and was born near Lynnville on Nov. 3, 1896. During World War I, he served in the armed forces.

On August 6, 1919, he was united in marriage with Velma Lucille Stanley at Des Moines. To this union were born three children: Mrs. Donald (Jelene) Brown of Grinnell, Marvin of Newton, and Donna, who died in infancy.

He is survived by his two children; a brother, Will of Grinnell; two nieces and two nephews; six grandchildren; and two brothers-in-law, Floyd and Harold Stanley of Grinnell.

His wife preceded him in death in January of this year and his infant daughter died in 1937.

Mr. Steenhoek had farmed most of his life and resided at the home place southeast of Grinnell since 1930. He was a member of the Westfield Community church.

Burial will be in Westfield cemetery.
