**Almond Stevenson Rites
Held Monday Afternoon**

The funeral of Almond Stevenson was held from the Steffy Funeral Home Monday afternoon, April 19, with the Rev. Wm. Morehouse officiating at the service. Mrs. Lyle Cole was the organist.

Interment was in Jackson Township Cemetery with Harold Johnston, Ray Herbrandt, Warren Stevenson, Raymond Grimm, Roy Baird and Bud Baird serving as casketbearers.

Almond, son of Rosalia and William Stevenson, was born on a farm north of Deep River, Jan. 12, 1887. He died in Montezuma, Saturday, April 17, at 78 years of age as the result of a fall.
