Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. today (Monday, July 17) at the Smith Funeral Home for Fred T. Stone, 83, of 1801 10th Ave. Place, who died Thursday evening at Grinnell General Hospital.

The Rev. Glenn Dieken, pastor of the Traer United Presbyterian church, officiated at the services.

The son of John H. and Elizabeth Shadel Stone, Mr. Stone was born Oct. 16, 1888, in Sheridan Township in Poweshiek County. He attended the rural schools of Sheridan and Grant Townships.

On March 8, 1916, Mr. Stone married Louise Farrand in Kansas City, Mo. To this union two sons were born, John F. Stone of Mason City and Paul R. Stone of Grinnell.

Mr. Stone farmed the home place for several years. Following their marriage, Mr. and Mrs. Stone farmed southwest of Malcom. They lived there for more than 50 years.

In 1969, Mr. and Mrs. Stone moved to Grinnell to make their home. Mrs. Stone died March 28, 1970.

Survivors include his two sons, John and Paul; eight grandchildren—John, Phillip and Robert of Mason City, Lowell of Center Point, and Marcia, Mary, Marla and Paula of Grinnell; ~~one great-~~grandson, Richard Stone, and one sister, Mrs. Nellie E. Hess of Grinnell.
