John Hubert Stone, the son of M and Mrs. T. L. Stone was born March 5th 1858 in Clearfield Co., Pa. and died Nov. 30th 1930 at Grinnell, Ia. aged 72 years, 8 months and 25 days.

He came to Tama Co., Ia. with his parents in 1866 where they lived for two years. They then moved to a farm in Madison township, Poweshiek Co. where he grew to manhood. July 2, 1885, he was united in marriage with Elizabeth Shadel. They lived two years in Madison township then moved to Sheridan township where they lived for 16 years. Later they moved to Grant township where they lived for 15 years and 12 years ago they moved to Grinnell.

Unto this home were born seven children, Henry of Grinnell, Fred & Malcom, Nellie, now Mrs. Lester Hess of Brooklyn, John who died in infancy, George and Lewis of Jefferson, Ia. and Vivian, now Mrs. Earl Fowler of Grinnell.

Mr. Stone was a great lover of home. He was devoted to his family and no sacrifice was too great for him to make when the interests of his family were involved.

He was a charter member of the Woodman Lodge of Sheridan where he held his membership at the time of his death. Until July, 1924, he enjoyed good health. At that time he was stricken with paralysis. He gradually grew worse until about a year ago. Since that time he had been confined to his home and for the past five months he was bedfast.

He leaves to mourn his loss his beloved wife, and children, also ten grandchildren, his brother George T. Stone of Brooklyn and a host of friends.

Short funeral services were conducted at the home Wednesday by Rev. A. B. Cadwell and then at the Sheridan church. Interment was in the Sheridan cemetery.
