Mrs. Stroud Dies; Services Tuesday

Mrs. Etta Mae Stroud, 85, the widow of Merton J. Stroud, of Rte. 2, Grinnell, passed away Sunday afternoon at a Newton, Ia., nursing home. Mrs. Stroud had made her home in Newton the last year and a half.
