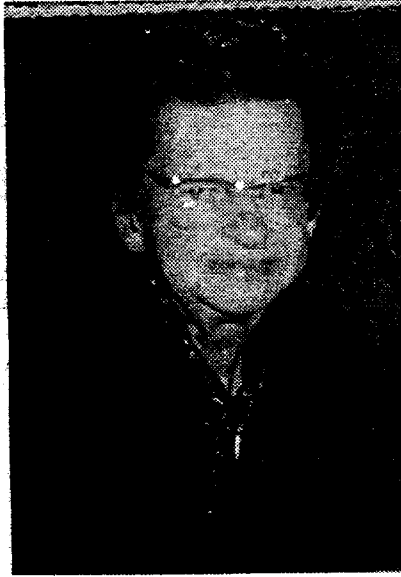


Alice Anderson



Alice Anderson, 93, of Grinnell died Tuesday, Dec. 14, 2004, at St. Francis Manor Care Center.

She is survived by three nephews, Ray Bulens of Grinnell, Jim Hanson, Rock Island, and Jerry Hanson, Mason, Ohio. She was preceded in death by her parents, one brother Ted Anderson and two sisters Pearl Bulens and Hazel Hanson.
