

Simon Haunsperger

Simon (Bud) Haunsperger of Sarasota, Fla., formerly of Kellogg, died Sept. 28, 2004, in Sarasota.

Interment will take place at a later date in Our Silent City Cemetery in Kellogg. Memorials may be made to the Kellogg Historical Society.

The son of Simon and Elizabeth Haunsperger, he was born Nov. 6, 1913, in Alton, Ill. He was married in 1937 to Alma Godfrey of Grinnell.
