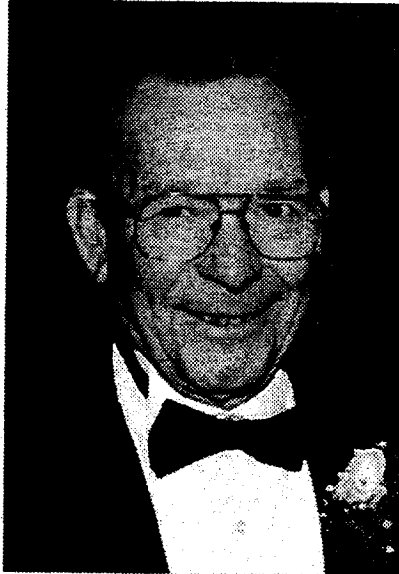


Calvin Kingery
