

Terpstra, 78, dies in Monroe

Leslie Dow Terpstra, 78, a Monroe resident since 1973 and long a Jasper and Poweshiek County farmer, died Wednesday at the Iowa Lutheran Hospital in Des Moines.

Funeral Services for Leslie Terpstra were held at 10 a.m. Saturday at the Monroe United Methodist Church, with the Rev. Jerry Wolcott, pastor of the church, officiating.

Burial was in the Hewitt Cemetery in Reasnor.
