

## Mr. Thompson memorial set

Harold A. Thompson, 59, formerly of Grinnell, died Monday afternoon, Aug. 29, in Riverside, Calif.

The body was cremated. A memorial service will be conducted at 2 p.m. Tuesday, Sept. 6, at the Calvary Baptist Church here, with the Rev. Damon Reese officiating. Music will be provided by Teresa Thompson, organist, and Mr. and Mrs. LeRoy Calvin, vocalists.
