Harold H. Tice, 89, of 1821 Spring St., Grinnell, died Wednesday, July 27, at Grinnell Regional Medical Center.

Funeral services were conducted Saturday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Kenneth Wallace, pastor of the Newburg-Chester Parish, officiating.
