John Tiedemann Funeral Services Slated Friday

John A. Tiedemann, 87, of 1019 Summer Street, died Wednesday morning at a local hospital following an extended illness.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Friday at the Trinity Lutheran church with the Rev. John Pannkuk, pastor, officiating. Organ music will be provided by Mrs. Kenneth Plum.

Pallbearers will be Wayne Gropper, Earl Gropper, Burton Tschopp, Ernest Wickersham, John Tschopp and Esper Tiedemann. Serving on the flower committee will be Dorothy Tschopp and Naomi Gropper.

Interment will be in Trinity Lutheran cemetery.

The son of John C. and Sophia Puls Tiedemann, he was born Aug. 13th, 1878, at Walnut, Ill. When he was a youngster his parents moved to a farm east of Grinnell where he attended the rural schools.

For many years he and his brother, Fred, farmed east of Grinnell until their retirement in 1946 when they moved to Grinnell.

He was a baptized and confirmed member of Trinity Lutheran church.

Survivors include one brother, Lou Tiedemann of Grinnell; four sisters, Pauline Jentzen, Mary Mithelman and Ella Gropper, all of Grinnell, and Leda Tschopp of Marshalltown.

He was preceded in death by his parents, a brother, Fred; and two sisters, Christine, who died in infancy, and Emma Jentzen.
