## Louis Tiedemann Services Held

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Sunday, March 2, at the James Schalinske Funeral Home for Louis C. Tiedemann, 93, of 927 High St., who died Thursday morning at Grinnell General Hospital following a brief illness.

The Rev. Ronald Spears officiated at the ceremonies. Organist was Mrs. Leonard Pearce. Pallbearers were Wayne Gropper,

Earl Gropper, Burton Tschopp, Eugene Staecker, Fred D. Lidtka and Garold Lidtka.

Burial was in Ivy Hill Cemetery at Malcom.

The son of John and Sophia Puls Tiedemann, Mr. Tiedemann was born Oct. 15, 1875 in Bureau County, Illinois. As a young man he came to Iowa with his parents and they settled just south of Trinity Lutheran Church in Malcom. Later they moved to a farm just west of Grinnell.

On Sept. 11, 1901, Mr. Tiedemann married Ellen Schultz at Malcom. Following their marriage they farmed for 37 years in the Malcom Community and in 1938 they moved to Grinnell. Since the death of his wife on June 5, 1951, he has made his home with his daughter, Mrs. C. Raymond White.

Survivors include one daughter, Mrs. C. Raymond (Effie) White of Grinnell; two sons, Lyle of Ukiah, Calif. and Esper of Grinnell; six grandchildren; ten great-grandchildren; one great great grandchild; and one sister, Mrs. Leda Tschopp of Marshalltown.

Mr. Tiedemann was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, Ellen; a son, Vinton (Pud) on April 5, 1936; and five sisters and two brothers.
