## Service Dec. 30 For W.E. Tindle Native of Malcom

William Earl Tindle was born at Velpen, Ind., to Harve and Nancy Tindle, Apr. 22, 1891. He was united in marriage with Emma Taylor, May 27, 1911, and to this union four children were born.

The family moved to Malcom in 1917 and the remainder of his life was spent farming in that vicinity. He was a member of the Methodist church in Malcom and was a loyal member of the Board of Trustees for many years. Death took him Dec. 26 at the home of a daughter, Mrs. Lucille Catterson, at Oskaloosa. He was 69 years of age.
