Funeral Services ^{H-R} For Willis Tingle Today At Harlan

Funeral services for Willis G. Tingle, 69, Grinnell, who died suddenly Sunday morning, were held this afternoon (Thursday) at Harlan. Burial was at De-fiance with Smith Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

The son of William Eldred and Jessie Thompson Tingle, he was born in Shelby county on Oct. 12th, 1892. The family lived in the Earling area for a time and then moved to South Dakota, where they settled in Armour and later at White Lake. He received much of his education at White Lake.

In 1914, he was united in marriage with Mae Scroggins and they lived in South Dakota until 1929. To this union were born three children: Raymond and Melvin Tingle of Madras, Ore., and Omar Tingle of Rolling Hills, Calif.

After leaving South Dakota, Mr. Tingle lived in Harlan, Iowa, for a time. He was married for the second time to Charlotte Smith and to this union three children were born: De Liela, La Donna and Janice Tingle, all of Dension.

They lived in Belle Plaine and moved to Grinnell 17 years ago. He was employed as a trucker and was a member of the Grinnell Eagles Lodge.

Survivors include his six children; nine grandchildren; two brothers, Eldred Tingle of Ingelwood, Calif., and Glen Tingle of Letcher, S. D.; and one sister, Mrs. Sadie Dodds of Santa Anna, Calif.

He was preceded in death by his parents, one brother and one sister.
