H.R. Charles Tish 3-27-1952

Charles Tish the son of Samuel Randolph, and Alice Catharine Shafer Tish was born in Sugar Creek, township near Searsboro, Ia., on July 26, 1864, and died at his home in Blue Point, Ia., March 14, 1952, aged 87 years 7 months 16 days.

On November 22, 1891, he was married to Lois Ann Spillman and to them were born two daughters, Verda Murrel, and Vergie Mabel who are living in the home. Mrs. Tish died March 7th 1938. His main interest was in his home and family.
