## Mrs. Hazel Tish

Hazel Lorene, daughter of Ed-  
ward and Francelia Bogert Wat-  
son, was born on a farm southeast  
of Searsboro, in Sugar Creek  
Township, Poweshiek County,  
Iowa, on August 1, 1895. She died  
in Grinnell, Iowa, on January 13,  
1980 at 84 years of age.

In her youth she attended  
Hickory Grove rural school and  
New Sharon High School, grad-  
uating with the Class of 1915.

On February 16, 1916, she was
