

Darrell "Butch" Van Lancker 7-18-79

Funeral services were held on Thursday, July 12, at 11 a.m. at the McAninch-Fremming Funeral Home in Victor for Darrell T. (Butch) Van Lancker, age 41, of Cedar Rapids. Mr. Van Lancker died Monday, July 9, 1979 upon arrival at St. Luke's Methodist Hospital in Cedar Rapids after suffering a heart attack.

The Rev. Eugene Hoenig, pastor of St. Bridget's Catholic Church in Victor, officiated at the funeral services. Organist was Mrs.

At the time of his death he was a member of St. Bridget's Catholic Church in Victor, Iowa.

Mr. Van Lancker is survived by his mother—Mrs. Mamie Van Lancker of Ladora; two brothers—Vernon Van Lancker of West Palm Beach, Fla., and Larry Van Lancker of Cedar Rapids.
