

## Brian L. Van Maanen

Brian "Pizza" Van Maanen, 35, of Lynnville was electrocuted in an accident at Old Mill Feeds in Lynnville late Thursday, Oct. 13.

Funeral services were conducted Monday at the Lynnville Friends Church, with the Rev. Marvin D. Miller officiating. Burial was in Woodland Cemetery, Lynnville, with the Van Dyk-Duven Funeral Home of Pella in charge of arrangements.

The son of Walton Alvin and Violet Helen Roorda Van Maanen, he was born June 7, 1959, in Salina, Kan. The family moved to Lynnville where he was raised and lived the remainder of his life. He was a 1977 graduate of Lynnville-Sully High School. While in high school he participated in F.F.A. and acquired the nickname "Pizza."

He had been employed at Lynnville Mill and Power for the past 16 years, working as a short-haul truck driver.

Surviving are his parents; one brother, Bryce; one sister, Brenda Jo; and his maternal grandmother, Jeannette Roorda of Sully. He was preceded in death by a sister, Sally Jo Van Maanen; his maternal grandfather, Gerard Roorda; and his paternal grandparents, Teunis and Rika Van Maanen.
