Ina VanNimwegen, 92, of the Mayflower, died Monday, Nov. 16, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Memorial services were conducted Wednesday in Denison Chapel at the Mayflower, with the Rev. David Bowman officiating. Pianist was Norman Goodbrod. Burial was in Rose Hill Cemetery, Eagle Grove, with the Smith Funeral Home of Grinnell in charge of arrangements.

She was the daughter of Reyer and Jane Colthof Brandts and was born Sept. 1, 1900, in Sioux Center, where she attended school.

She was married to Edward VanNimwegen Nov. 6, 1923, in Orange City. The couple lived in Alton for nine years before moving to Eagle Grove in 1932. Mrs. VanNimwegen moved to the Mayflower in 1964. She was a member of the Grinnell United Church of Christ-Congregational.
