

## Bryan Van Norden

Bryan E. Van Norden, 30, of Yuma, Ariz., formerly of Sully, died of a self-inflicted gunshot wound Thursday, Jan. 25, at the Yuma Medical Center.

Funeral services were conducted Thursday at the first Reformed Church of Sully, with the Rev. Brice Hoyt officiating.

Pallbearers were Bryon "Dutch" Van Norden, Joel VandeKrol, Lance Brand, Tompy Thompson, Maury Van Der Wilt and Jeremy Keen. Honorary bearers were Jeff Rozendaal, Allen Criswell, and Guy Arney.

Burial was in Sully Cemetery, with military honors presented by the Grinnell Veterans Ceremonial Unit.

The son of Tunis and Kathy Criswell Van Norden, he was born Oct. 3, 1965, in Grinnell. He was raised in Sully and graduated from Lynnville-Sully High School in 1984. He served in the U.S. Marine Corps for 7 1/2 years. While in the service, he received electronic training and was stationed in Yuma as a radar operator. He was later stationed in Alabama and California. Following his discharge, he returned to Yuma and worked as an electrical engineer at the Yuma Medical Center.

He is survived by his wife, Tammy of Yuma; two daughters, Tannatha and Breana; his brother, Bryon "Dutch" Van Norden of Newton; and two sisters, Jocelyn Keen and Jaci Van Norden, both of Sully.
