Former Resident, Homer Van Treese Dies In Chicago

Homer Van Treese, 51, of Chicago, Ill., formerly of Grinnell, died Tuesday morning at a Chicago hospital.

Funeral services were held Wednesday morning in Chicago. Graveside services will be held at 11 a.m., Friday at Hazelwood cemetery here with the Rev. Ronald G.
