

## Donald Vance

Donald B. Vance, 77, of Grinnell died of cancer Friday, June 28, at Grinnell Regional Medical Center.

Graveside services will be at 10 a.m. Tuesday at Hazelwood Cemetery, with the Rev. Robert Molsberry, pastor of the United Church of Christ - Congregational, officiating. The Smith Funeral Home is in charge of arrangements.

Surviving are his wife; two daughters, Beth Granberry of Asherton, Texas, and Becky Sedrel of Diablo, Calif.; three grandchildren; and one sisters, Margaret Martin of Chapel Hill, N.C.
