WM. VAUGHAN DEAD.

Wm. Vaughan was born August 23, 1823, in Lawrence county, Canada, and died April 1, 1900, in Grinnell, Ia. He came to Lee county, Iowa, in 1845. Two years later he went to Schuyler county, Mo., remaining there until 1861 when he removed to Jasper county, of which he has been a continuous resident until his death, living most of the time in Kellogg. He united with the M. E. church in childhood and for 50 years he has been a faithful and devoted member of the church. He was one of the founders of the Methodist church in Kellogg. He leaves a wife, four sons and two daughters, all of whom are Christians and have gone to their reward which, we believe, is a better land. May we all strive to be like him that we may one day meet him in that better land.

The funeral services were held in the Kellogg M. E. church, April 3, at 11 o'clock. Funeral sermon was preached by Rev. D. R. Martin, assisted by Rev. W. L. Brandt. The services at the cemetery were conducted by the I. O. O. F. lodge, of which he has been a member since 1870.
